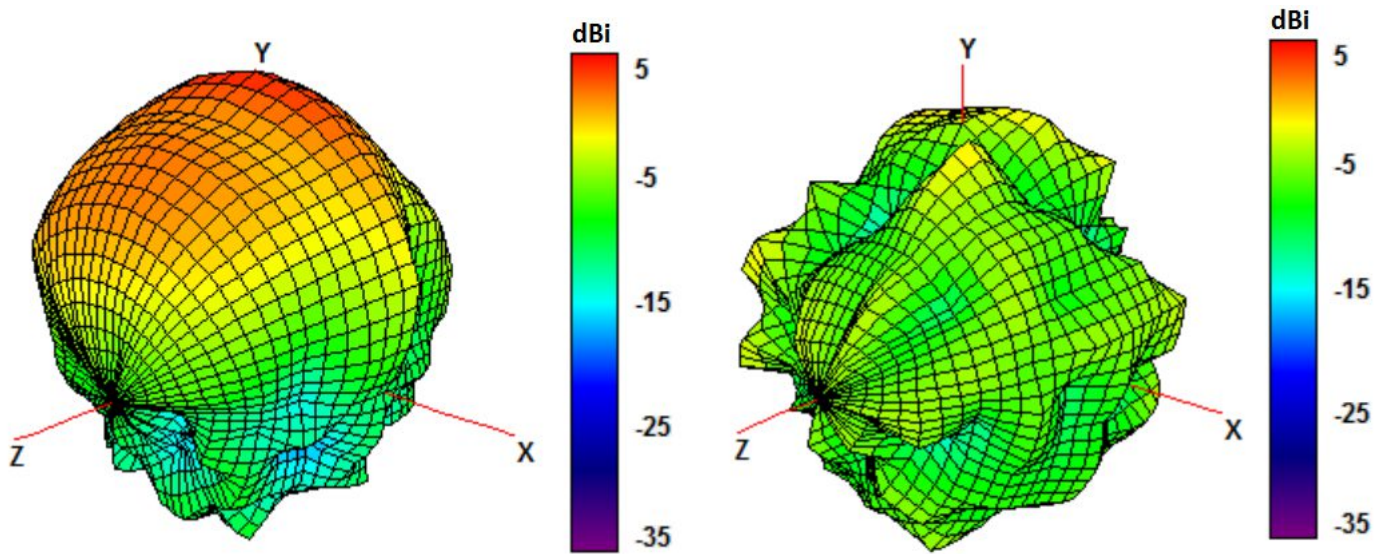

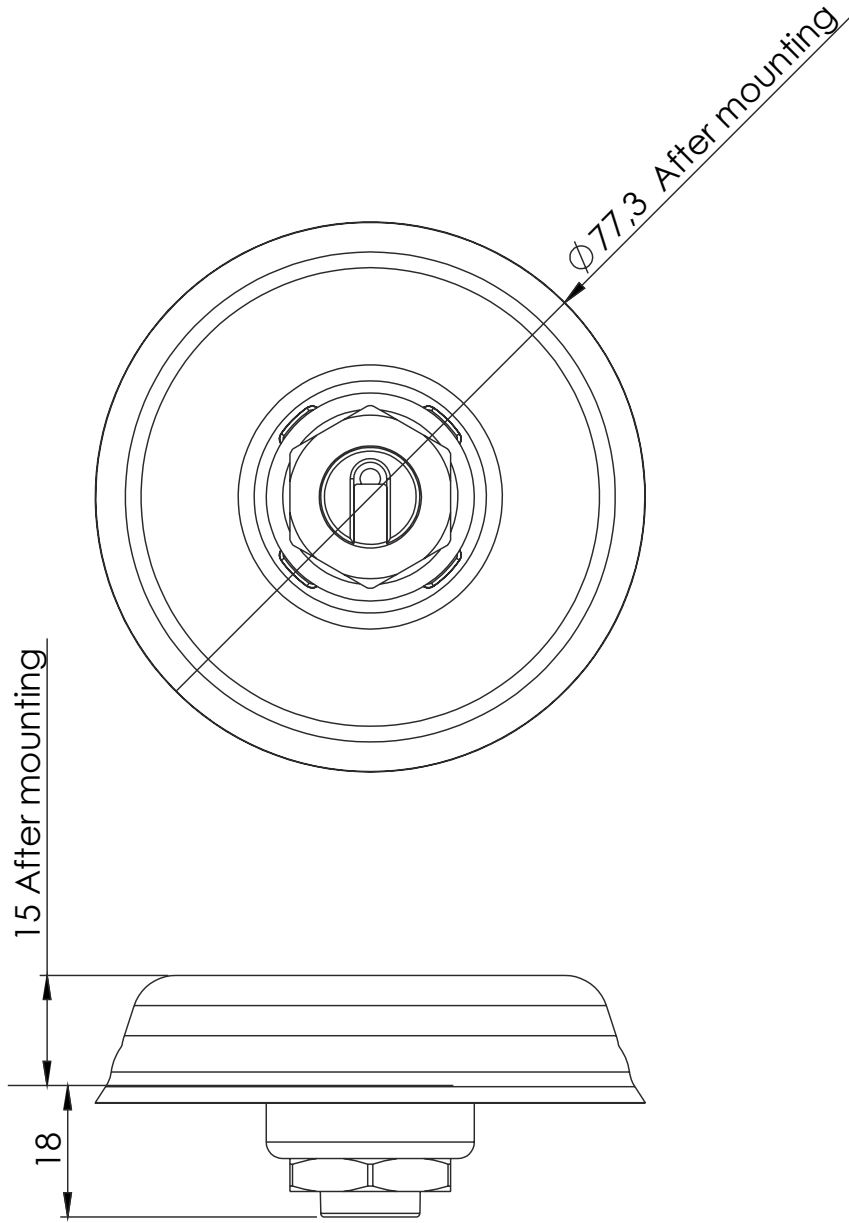


Radiation pattern reference
